Dear Parent or Guardian,

This letter is written in response to a directive we received on March 22, 2017. The directive was to authorize and provide: **Referral to an inpatient treatment facility providing neurological evaluation and treatment; and, continued residential treatment until the enrollee is relocated to a suitable inpatient facility or is otherwise determined to no longer need residential treatment.**

We have approved the request for continued C&A RTC with the following authorizations:

- Authorization **211396160** is good from **March 23, 2017 to March 31, 2017**
- Authorization **211396508** is good from **April 1, 2017 to April 30, 2017.**

This authorization may be extended until an appropriate discharge plan is in place.

UnitedHealthcare Community Plan is currently working with Youth Villages to identify the appropriate lower level of care for Dylan. Once we identified this care, we will issue an authorization number and ensure Dylan is transitioned to the appropriate level of care based on his needs.

We called Melanie Galimore with Youth Villages and gave her this information. Dylan was admitted to Youth Villages through the Department of Children's Services on January 25, 2017 and will continue receiving **C&A RTC** until his doctor feels he is ready for discharge and the appropriate level of care is arranged.

We have approved the request for a neurological evaluation. An approval number is not required for this service.

On April 11, 2017, we contacted Memphis Neurology at 901-405-0275 and scheduled Dylan an appointment for a neurological evaluation for May 17, 2017 at 8:45 AM with Ronald Lynn, MD. Memphis Neurology is located at 7645 Wolf River Circle, Suite 100, Germantown, TN 38138.
