COMPLAINT AGAINST LINDY ROBBINS

I refer to the Commission's previous correspondence and advise that I have now had an opportunity to consider your complaint.

In essence, your complaint is that Ms Lindy Robbins of McDuff & Guilfoyle Lawyers did not give prior notice of her intention to attend in a professional capacity at a disciplinary meeting between yourself and a former employee, Mr Kurt Yelds.

You also raise concerns that during a meeting on 11 December 2019, Ms Robbins identified herself as working for the law practice, McDuff & Guilfoyle Lawyers, however Mr Yelds refers to her as a 'friend' in his affidavit.

On review of the Commission's records, I note that you made a similar complaint about the conduct of Ms Robbins on 14 May 2020. The complaint was dismissed on 5 June 2020.

You were dissatisfied with the outcome of your complaint and requested that I undertake a reconsideration of my decision. A reconsideration (74200553) was conducted and my decision was affirmed on 18 August 2020.

You appear to have raised the same issues again.

In my previous correspondence, I explained that I was not able to identify any conduct on the part of Ms Robbins which I would consider to be unethical and furthermore, that your complaint did not disclose any conduct that I consider may amount to unsatisfactory professional conduct or professional misconduct.

I advise that I do not intend to take any further action in respect of your complaint. Accordingly, pursuant to section 432(1)(d) of the *Legal Profession Act 2007*, I have decided to dismiss your complaint and will close the Commission's file accordingly.
